Dear Dr. Achúcazzo,

I am sorry to have been so busy during this week as not to have time to write to you before. It is very kind of you to take the trouble to write to Madrid on my account and I beg you to accept my warmest thanks.

From Del Rio Hortega I should merely like to know if he has received my letter~~s~~ of last July and if he has been able to get in Madrid a few grams of gold chloride for Cajal's neuroglia staining method. I am unable to get it in this country and it is also extremely difficult to obtain<sup>f</sup> from Germany. Perhaps if some friend of yours is coming to this country during the winter he could bring it together with some Thionine (10 grams) and some Toluidine blue (10 grams).

Naturally I wish to pay for these reagents as soon as I know their cost.

As to the paper of Borda = Paralysie générale progressive, Revista de la Sociedad Médica Argentina, xiii, 1905, Buenos Ayres - I wonder if such a journal can be found in some medical library of Madrid and if so whether I could

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have a copy or an abstract of this paper which I need for
