Dr. A.H.T. Robb-Smith.

It is understood that Dr. Robb-Smith has applied to you for permission to live for a short period in the Students' Residence at Madrid, and that before permission can be given for him to do so, a reference is required as to his suitability.

Dr. Robb-Smith is at present the holder of a Dorothy Temple Cross Research Fellowship in Tuberculosis which was awarded to him by the Medical Research Council, who are the Trustees of the Fund concerned. For the past ten months, he has been working in the department of Dr. L. Aschoff at Freiburg, Germany, on the pathology of pulmonary tuberculosis. His fellowship has two more months to run, and during that period he desires to work under Professor R. Hortega in Madrid, in order to learn new technical methods which will enable him to extend his research to problems of tuberculous meningitis.

The Medical Research Council have every reason to think that Dr. Robb-Smith is both by personal character and academic interests an entirely suitable person to be permitted accomodation in the Students' Residence at Madrid.
