DEAR MARGOLIOUTH,

I would like to apply for renewal of the appointments of Dr. Pío del Río Hortega and Senorita del Río for one year from 8 November 1938. The experiment of having Dr. Río Hortega at Oxford has been a success. When he arrived in Oxford last November he was able to begin work at once in the Department of Human Anatomy through the courtesy of Professor Le Gros Clark. He was largely responsible for the equipment of the laboratory at the Radcliffe Infirmary and he moved into this new building in May.

Since he has worked steadily at the classification of intracranial tumours. The quality of his histological work is superior to anything that I have seen before. He has prepared two lectures for delivery this Term, and is engaged in a new edition of his book on the tumours of the Nervous System, which I hope will be published in English, and by the University Press.

Senorita del Río has worked well as a Grade II technician.

I would like to propose that Dr. Río Hortega's salary be raised from 600 to 700 Pounds and that Senorita del Río's salary remain the same.
