MEMBERS.

THE Members of Common Room are the President, Fellows and Honorary Fellows.

HONORARY MEMBERS.

Honorary Members of Common Room are entitled to dine at High Table and also to attend Common Room in term time, except on Domus nights (Gaudies), and to bring one or two guests.

Honorary Members may put down their names for luncheon in Common Room in term time, and for luncheon or dinner in Common Room in the vacation, on days when those meals are being provided there for Fellows. It is requested that Honorary Members notify their intention to lunch or dine by noon on the day itself at the Porter's Lodge. If there should not be room in Hall or Common Room, the Porter will inform them accordingly.

Honorary Members may be able to obtain the occasional use of a dining room for a small party by arrangement with the Junior Bursar. Wine for such parties can be obtained from the stock kept in the College by Messrs. Harvey and Son, of Bristol.

No entrance fee or subscription is charged to Honorary Members. Their battels bill will be sent terminally or yearly for the meals, &c., supplied.

All Doctors and Masters on the books of the College, including those who pay their dues through other Colleges, are entitled to dine at High Table in term time, except on Domus nights, provided that there is room.
